JUROR OF AWARDS

Roxana Velásquez Martínez del Campo

American born and raised in Mexico, Roxana Velásquez is the current Executive Director of the San Diego Museum of Art (SDMA) in California. Prior to her appointment in 2010, she has served as director of the Museo Nacional de San Carlos, Museo Nacional de Arte (Munal), and the Museo del Palacio de Bellas Artes in Mexico City representing professional, civic, and cultural endeavors that elevated each institution to international recognition. Ms. Velásquez is a member of the Board of Trustees at the Association of Art Museum Directors, the International Council of Museums, and the Asociación Mexicana de Profesionales de Museos. She has been distinguished by the King of Spain with the Cross of Isabel la Católica for outstanding cultural projects of Spanish art organized in Mexico. In her pursuit to foster cross-cultural dialogues Roxana connected with many institutions worldwide and was invited on various occasions by the Governments of Belgium, China, France, Italy and Poland to name a few. She organized and curated remarkable exhibitions namely Goya, Rubens and His Time, From the Academy to the Impressionism, Masterpieces of the 19th Century European Paintings, René Magritte and Frida Kahlo Centennial Exhibition.

ELIGIBILITY

The Annual Exhibition is open to all artists. Paintings must be primarily water-based media on a paper surface and unvarnished (Yupo & Tyvek are permitted). Other media, if used, must be in conjunction with water media. Water media must be the dominant element. No digital media, photography, prints or reproductions may be used anywhere in the painting. No work that has been previously exhibited in any national show may be entered. (A national show is any show that accepts national or international entries.) Work must have been completed within the last two years. Paintings done in a class or workshop setting may not be submitted. Source material must be original and not derived from any published images.

JURYING PROCEDURES AND SEQUENCE

The Annual Exhibition is selected in two stages: an initial review and tentative selection from all images submitted and a later verification of those paintings tentatively accepted. Paintings that do not match the submitted entry in content or quality may be eliminated in the second jurying. Improperly framed pieces may also be rejected at this time. The Juror of Awards then reviews the accepted paintings and determines the awards and the Travel Exhibition.

ACCEPTED WORKS

Please check our web page on Aug 20 to see a list of Accepted Artists/Paintings. Artists whose submissions are accepted in the initial jurying process will receive labels and instructions for shipping and delivery.

DIGITAL ENTRY (July 27 Deadline)

Artists may submit <u>one</u> digital entry by mailing in the DVD/CD/Flash Drive. Dlgital image should be RGB color in jpeg format and should be sized at 72 resolution, and 1920 pixels on longest side. You may also upload your image by going to **www.nationalwatercolorsociety.org** and following the upload directions for CAFE. Size restriction for CAFE is 72 resolution, 1920 pixels for the longest dimension and file size not larger than 3mb.

ENTRY FEES (Nonrefundable)

Signature Members and Associates whose dues have been paid for the current year may submit one image for an entry fee of \$25. Fee for Non-members is \$40. You can send a check or postal money order payable in U.S. funds and mailed with your Data Card or if you use CAFE you can pay with a credit/debit card. All uploads to CAFE must be paid to CAFE. All entrants will receive a catalog of the 92nd Annual Exhibition.

TRAVELING EXHIBITION

A traveling exhibition of 30 paintings will be chosen by the Juror of Awards for a one-year national tour. Please be sure to mark the circle on your Data Card if your painting is available for this honor.

SALES

All work MUST be for sale. The National Watercolor Society is responsible for all sales and will retain a 30% commission. Although the utmost care will be taken in handling paintings and shipping containers, NWS and its representatives cannot be responsible for damage or loss, whatever the cause. Artists should carry their own insurance. There will be no price changes after acceptance in the 92nd Annual Exhibition.

FRAMING LIMITATIONS

Minimum Image Size: 9" x 12". Maximum Frame Size is 40" on longest side. The frame must be simple but sturdy enough to support the artwork without buckling the Plexiglas. No glass will be accepted. Diptychs and triptychs must be mounted within a single frame. The painting must be ready for hanging with wire and secured under rigid Plexiglas. No saw tooth hangers. Mats, if used, must be a white or light neutral color unless an integral part of the artwork.

SIGNATURE MEMBERSHIP IN THE NWS

An Associate or non-member whose painting is accepted in the Annual will be invited by the President of the Society to apply for Signature Membership. The artists will be asked to submit three matted works, excluding the exhibited work, for review by the Jury of Selection. If the paintings are judged to meet the standards of quality and consistency required by the Society, the applicant will be invited to become a Signature Member in the National Watercolor Society. Acceptance into three Annual Open Exhibitions will also earn the artist Signature Membership.

ASSOCIATES OF THE NWS

Artists and friends of watercolor may become Associates of the Society merely by applying and paying the required annual dues. Benefits include all announcements of NWS activities, the Newsletter, Prospectus, Catalog of the National Exhibition and reduced entry fee for the Annual Show. Associates are eligible to enter the NWS Member Show. Associates may not vote or use NWS initials after their name. The NWS membership year runs from April 1 to March 31.
